**PURPOSE**

i-SAFE's Professional Development Program will prepare educators, counselors and law enforcement personnel to become i-SAFE Program Leaders and Classroom Instructors. Training participants will receive a comprehensive explanation of Internet safety concepts. By completing the Professional Development Program and registering with i-SAFE, training participants will have access to i-SAFE's entire web-based curriculum for grades K-12 and outreach components. All training participants will receive an i-SAFE Professional Development Program Leader's Guide.

- Increase competence in i-SAFE's five core internet curriculum areas.
- Increase self-confidence in ability to integrate internet safety and prevention into classroom and community settings.
- Understand that the empowerment of youth and adults is central to foster virtual safety.

As such, she oversees the coordination of the prevention education initiatives that HelpLine provides around the topics of Suicide Prevention, Sexual and Family Violence Prevention, and Child Sexual Assault Prevention. In addition, she supports the implementation of the Sexual Assault Response Network, a program of HelpLine.

Involved as a volunteer and professional with social justice advocacy work since the mid-1990s, she is concerned with the ways in which cultural identity, privilege, and oppression inform our ability to provide effective prevention and intervention services to those in the community.

She is a certified trainer for i-SAFE, Stewards of Children and LifeSkills. Julianna is also the current convener of the Delaware County Suicide Prevention Coalition and the PEACE (Prevention Education in All Classroom Environments) Collaborative and is the co-chair of the Ohio Sexual and Intimate Partner Violence Prevention Consortium. In addition, she is active on the Delaware and Morrow Sexual Assault Response Teams and is working to found the Ohio Alliance to End Sexual Violence.
